Fr. Jonathan Raia

Fr. Jonathan Raia is the Vocation Director and Director of Seminarians for the Diocese of Austin. He was born in Houston, Texas into a strong Catholic family, where he came to know Jesus Christ as his Lord, Savior and Friend. He felt a call to the priesthood as early as his First Holy Communion, but discerned the call most seriously while a student at the University of Texas at Austin. Bishop Danny Garcia

Bishop Joe S. Vásquez appointed then Very Rev. Daniel E. Garcia as the Vicar General for the Diocese of Austin and Moderator of the Curia on March 3, 2014. On Jan. 21, 2015, Pope Francis appointed him as Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Austin. Bishop Garcia is the first auxiliary bishop in the history of the diocese. He was installed on March 3, 2015. Previously he was the pastor of St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Austin. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Austin on May 28, 1988.
